# **Our History**

In 1997, Sherman Chan and Irma Velasquez established a multidisciplinary team to provide intensive educational and therapeutic support for their son, Aaron, who had been diagnosed with autism. Recognizing Aaron's need for effective communication, the team tirelessly explored various methods until he began expressing his needs and wants.

To further develop his social and communication skills, they sought an immersive social environment. After extensive research in the San Francisco Bay Area, they identified a gap in suitable educational settings for children with autism. This led to the creation of WINGS in September 2001, with a mission to provide a nurturing learning environment where autistic students could grow at their own pace.


