

WINGS LEARNING CENTER (WINGS), a non-public school certified by the California Department of Education, is actively seeking dedicated individuals to join our Board of Directors and committees. Our organization has been a steadfast advocate for individuals with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) for over two decades. Our unwavering mission is to enhance the quality of life for individuals with ASD across their entire lifespan, particularly focusing on those with moderate to severe autism and similar intellectual disabilities stemming from various genetic or neurological diagnoses.

WINGS boasts a world-class interdisciplinary team committed to addressing the unique needs of our students and their families. We offer individualized educational curricula and therapeutic programs that encompass speech pathology, occupational therapy, behavior management, and sensory integration. This personalized approach ensures that each student's developmental needs are met, targeting crucial skill areas to promote more independence.

The age range for students admitted at WINGS spans from five to 22 years old, offering both elementary and secondary educational programs. Importantly, we provide essential speech therapy and occupational therapy services to facilitate a comprehensive educational experience. It's essential to note that our primary focus is to provide a functional-based educational program leading to a certificate of completion, different from the traditional high school diploma.

WINGS recently relocated to a new home in San Bruno at Rollingwood Elementary School, becoming a part of the vibrant San Bruno Park School District community. We are excited about actively engaging with this dynamic community and the surrounding area. Additionally, we place significant emphasis on attracting, preparing, and retaining special education professionals, aiming to serve a growing number of students. Our comprehensive approach includes innovative staff education, competitive compensation and benefits, and stimulating, inviting, and inspiring conditions. Initiatives range from recruitment incentives to college loan repayments, all designed to foster a culturally responsive and diverse educator workforce.

Looking ahead, WINGS has ambitious plans, including increasing annual fundraising through various channels, expanding our educational offerings to include a preschool program for ages 2-5 and an Adult program for those aged 22 and older, developing revenue-generating programs and services, and launching a Capital Campaign to secure a permanent home in the Bay Area in the near future. Our overarching goal is to support individuals and families, exceed educational outcomes, provide options and opportunities, and improve the overall quality of life for those impacted by ASD. By joining the WINGS community, individuals can make a significant impact on the lives of those affected by autism.








FY24 Budgeted Expenses & Income

Our History

When their son, Aaron, was diagnosed with autism in 1997, Sherman Chan and Irma Velasquez formed a multi-disciplinary team to provide an intensive educational and therapeutic program for him. Aaron's team realized that he needed an effective communication system. After trying different methods and approaches, Aaron began learning to communicate his needs and wants and make his requests known. However, it was clear to the team and to his parents that in order for him to learn social skills and expand his communication skills, he needed to be immersed in a social environment.

After years of visiting numerous educational settings in the San Francisco Bay Area, the team realized there was an unmet need for an environment where children with autism could learn social communication, academics, and independent living skills to function and grow.

In September of 2001, WINGS was created with the mission of creating a learning environment where students with autism could learn at their own pace and be inspired to take steps towards their own personal growth.


